**PRESENTATIONS** Consistency Awards will be presented prior to the commencement of matches on Grand Finals night.

#### **BYLAWS**

- 10.2 In the Spring competition teams shall consist of a minimum of three and a maximum of four players of any sex:
  - 1 matches shall comprise eleven rubbers of best of five games of eleven with advantage to be played if ten all;
  - 2 nine rubbers shall be singles and two rubbers shall be doubles;
  - in singles events each of the three singles players listed in the home team shall play each of the three singles players listed in the visiting team;
  - 4 two doubles combinations shall be formed in each team:
    - 1 no one distinct pair may play twice within the same match;
  - 5 all players and doubles combinations must be listed on the Score Sheet prior to commencement of the match;
  - 6 where a fourth player is played by a team, that player must play in the two doubles rubbers.
- 11.5 In the Spring competition a player shall have participated in a total of four matches in that team in that grade and / or in a team in a lower grade to be eligible to participate in any finals matches. Where a bye occurs in a grade, a player shall have participated in three matches in that team in that grade and / or in a team in a lower grade to be eligible to participate in any finals matches.
- 11.6 Any player not meeting the requirements of Bylaw 11.4 or 11.5 will not be eligible to play in finals except in the club's lowest graded team where prior approval of the Permit Committee has been granted.
- 13.1 Rubbers shall be played in the order set out on the Score Sheet unless mutually agreed to by both captains.
- 13.2 No table shall be vacant for a period greater than five minutes if there is the possibility of another game proceeding.
- 13.3 Advice to players can only be given at the end of each game in a rubber, never at the change of ends at 5 in the fifth game of the rubber.
- 14.5 1 In the Spring Competition, an individual player is not eligible to receive a Top Player Award if in the previous year that player received the same Award in that same or a higher grade, for that competition, except in the top grade.
