BYLAW 19 HEAT POLICY

Matches that are programmed in non-air conditioned venues shall be cancelled in the event that the temperature in Adelaide at 6.00pm on the day of the match is 34⁰C or greater.

Should a grade play in 2 or more venues, at least one of which is not air-conditioned, then all matches in that grade will be cancelled according to the rule of the Heat Policy.

In the event of such cancellation, Score Sheets for the cancelled match, listing the players must be forwarded as per Match Results bylaw (for finals qualification purposes only), and each team shall be awarded equal premiership points.

BYLAW 20 CHILD SAFE ENVIRONMENT POLICY

BYLAWS (extracts)

3 PLAYER PERMITS

- 3.1 Full permits will only be granted to Members.
1. A player registered in a particular grade cannot play in a lower grade unless they have written permission from the Permit Committee.
- 3.2 An unregistered player may play on a temporary permit for three matches only, as granted by the Permit Committee.
1. Before playing a fourth match that player must apply to the Recorder on a Player Registration Form in accordance with Bylaw 1.2.1;
 2. Until that player's registration is ratified by the Permit Committee he may continue to play on a temporary permit;
 3. If that player is not granted a full permit the Executive Committee shall determine the outcome of those matches in which the player participated; and,
 4. Where the unregistered player is a replacement player, if appropriate, the Permit Committee shall determine the outcome of those matches in which the player participated in accordance with Bylaw 4.2.
- 3.3 A player playing on a temporary permit **must** be indicated on the Score Sheet of both teams.
- 3.4 Any Club playing an unregistered player under their own name or the name of another player, or playing a player under a name other than that which they are registered shall be liable to a Penalty.
- Penalty -** Forfeiture of all rubbers in which the offending player participated.
- 3.5 A player may at all times be elevated to a higher grade by their Club.
1. After playing four matches in a higher team in a higher grade than that for which they are registered, that player is deemed qualified for that grade and cannot play in a lower grade without written Permit Committee approval.
- Penalty -** Forfeiture of all rubbers of the player involved.
- 3.6 A player must not play more than once in the same week unless;
1. The player is playing as a reserve for a higher team in an emergency, in accordance with Bylaw 3.5; or
 2. One match applies to a different round because of postponement.
- Penalty -** Forfeiture of all rubbers of the player involved.
- 3.7 In the event of a Club having more than one team in a grade, and in cases of genuine unavailability of a player, the Permit Committee may, upon request by the Club, and in its discretion, allow a reserve player to play in each of the Club's teams in that grade (maximum 3 matches in each team). By-Law 4.2 applies.

7 MATCH RESULTS

- 7.1 Within forty eight hours of the completion of a match, each team shall forward a copy of the Score Sheet in accordance with either Bylaw 7.2 or 7.3.
- 7.2 In minor rounds, results shall be forwarded by email:
- 1 the home team to the Result Steward; and,
 - 2 the visiting team to the Recorder.
- One team may on behalf of both teams provide a copy of the Score Sheet to both the Result Steward and the Recorder if the captains agree.
- 7.3 In finals, results shall be forwarded by email:
- 1 the winning team to the Result Steward; and,
 - 2 the losing team to the Recorder.
- 7.4 In the event of a forfeit the team receiving the forfeit must send a score sheet listing their players to both the Result Steward and the Recorder when claiming the forfeit thus crediting the players listed with a win for each of the singles forfeited.. The team forfeiting must send a score sheet, as per the program book, advising the forfeit.
- 7.5 Penalty - The penalty for the late return of match results shall be a fine of five dollars.

10 ARRANGEMENT OF PLAY Grades other than Super League

10.1 In the Winter competition the team shall consist of four or five players, with

- at least one male and
- at least one female or one junior player (refer to Bylaw 18)

(except for A Grade or as allowed by sub-rule 8 below) participating in the singles rubbers and playing in their order of merit on the following basis-

- 1 matches shall comprise twelve rubbers of best of five games of eleven, with advantage to be played if ten all;
- 2 eight rubbers shall be singles and four rubbers shall be doubles;
- 3 singles rubbers shall be played as follows:
 - 1 the no.1 player against the no.1 and no.2 players of the opposing team;
 - 2 the no.2 player against the no.2 and no.1 players of the opposing team;
 - 3 the no.3 player against the no.3 and no.4 players of the opposing team;
 - 4 the no.4 player against the no.4 and no.3 players of the opposing team;
- 4 a team may have a fifth player for the purposes of the doubles rubbers, which shall be played as follows:
 - 1 the no.1 and no.2 players against the no.1 and no.2 players of the opposing team;
 - 2 the no.3 and no.4 players against the no.3 and no.4 players of the opposing team;
 - 3 two further doubles rubbers may be of any other combination provided that, where there is a fifth player that player must play in those two rubbers, no distinct pair may play twice and no player may play more than two doubles rubbers within the same match;
- 5 all players and doubles combinations must be listed on the Score Sheet prior to commencement of the match;
- 6 if a team is unable to field a full team the available players must participate in the highest positions to be filled (such that any forfeited rubbers are to commence at no 4, and so on if applicable);
- 7 except in the case of unavailability of a player, no player may be moved greater than one position within a team's order of merit in any consecutive match unless the prior permission of the Permit Committee has been granted for any such move;
- 8 in B Grade and lower when neither a female player nor a junior player is available they may be replaced by a male player of equal or lower standard provided the prior approval of the Permit Committee has been granted for each such replacement;
- 9 Penalty - The penalty for any breach of this By-law is forfeiture of all rubbers won where the breach occurred. Such penalty shall be imposed by the Result Steward and the Recorder, who shall notify the team's Club Secretary and the Executive Committee of the imposition of the penalty. The Executive Committee may in its absolute discretion review, rescind or alter the penalty.

10.3 Super League Competition

In the Super League Grade in the Winter and Spring competition the team shall consist of three players (but may consist of four players) of any gender with each team having a player seeded, prior to the season commencing, as a number 1, 2 and 3.

The rules of play are the same as shown in Bylaw 10.2.

- 1 In the Super League Division in both the Winter and Spring seasons there is a total of 55 premiership points available for each match and these are awarded as follows with all matches (singles and doubles) being best of five games:
 - 1 If a player/s wins 3 games to 0 games then the winning player will receive 5 points and the losing player/s 0 points.
 - 2 If a player/s wins 3 games to 1 game then the winning player will receive 4 points and the losing player/s 1 point.
 - 3 If a player/s wins 3 games to 2 games then the winning player will receive 3 points and the losing player/s 2 points.

11 FINALS

11.1 Unless otherwise directed, in the Winter competition a first semi final shall be played between the first and second placed teams at the end of the minor round, and, a second semi final shall be played between the third and fourth placed teams at the end of the minor round.

- 1 The loser of the second semi final shall assume fourth place.
- 2 The winner of the second semi final shall play the loser of the first semi final in a preliminary final with the loser assuming third place.
- 3 The winner of the preliminary final shall play the winner of the first semi final in the grand final with the winner assuming first place, and the premiership, and the loser assuming second place (i.e. Runners Up).
4. In the event of a draw (rubbers and games equal) there shall be a deciding rubber of doubles played between any two players nominated by the captain of each team (Rule 10.1.4.3 does not apply to this rubber)

11.2 Unless otherwise directed, in the Spring competition a preliminary final shall be played between the second and third placed teams at the end of the minor round, with the loser assuming third place.

- 1 The winner of the preliminary final shall play the first placed team at the end of the minor round in the grand final, with the winner assuming first place and the premiership and the loser assuming second place.

11.3 In all finals matches the higher team shall be regarded as the home team and the lower team as the visiting team.

11.4 In the Winter competition a player shall have participated in a total of five matches in that team in that grade and / or in a team in a lower grade to be eligible to participate in any finals matches. Where a bye occurs in a grade, a player shall have participated in a total of four matches in that team in that grade and / or in a team in a lower grade to be eligible to participate in any finals matches.

11.6 Any player not meeting the requirements of Bylaw 11.4 or 11.5 will not be eligible to play in finals except in the club's lowest graded team where prior approval of the Permit Committee has been granted.

11.7 Teams may play players from lower grades as reserves in finals.

- 1 Should any player play in a higher grade under Bylaw 11.7 they shall not be permitted to play any finals match in a lower grade except with the written approval of the Permit Committee.

11.8 For the purposes of Bylaws 11.4 and 11.5 "participated" is deemed to include playing in any permissible combinations of singles and/or doubles rubbers. The player must also be registered in accordance with by-law 3.

11.9 In the Super League Division in the event that more than one team has the same number of premiership points won and lost at the end of the minor round then a count back is undertaken between only those teams involved:

- 1 most number of rubbers won – team placed highest
- 2 most number of games won – team placed highest
- 3 least number of games lost – team placed highest

12 BALLS

12.1 Only balls approved by TTSA and/or the CCTTA Executive Committee may be used in matches of the Association, subject to Bylaw 12.2

12.2 1 Balls used shall be in reasonable condition and acceptable to both captains.

2 Non-acceptance of the used ball shall not necessarily invalidate the match.

13 CONDUCT OF MATCHES

13.1 Rubbers shall be played in the order set out on the Score Sheet unless mutually agreed to by both captains

13.2 No table shall be vacant for a period greater than five minutes if there is the possibility of another game proceeding.

13.3 Advice to players can only be given at the end of each game in a rubber, never at the change of ends at 5 in the fifth game of the rubber.

18 JUNIOR PLAYERS

18.1 A Junior player is one who was under 18 years of age at December 31st of the previous calendar year.

THE SERVICE RULE

1. Service shall start with the ball resting freely on the open palm of the server's stationary free hand. The server shall then project the ball near vertically upwards without imparting spin, so that it rises at least 16cm after leaving the palm of the free hand and then falls without touching anything before being struck. As the ball is falling the server shall strike it so that it touches first the server's court and then, after passing over or around the net assembly, the receiver's court - in doubles, the ball shall touch successively the right half court of server and receiver.

2. From the start of service until it is struck, the ball shall be above the level of the playing surface and behind the server's end line, and it shall not be hidden from the receiver and umpire by any part of the body or clothing of the server or his/her doubles partner.

3. It is the responsibility of the player to serve so that the umpire can see that they comply with the requirements for a good service, which is an "OPEN" technique fully visible to both the receiver and umpire.
